Safety information



WARNING

Risk of electric shock due to live equipment!!!

Before any work is started, the following safety measures must be taken:

- Disconnect the voltage completely.
- · Mark the point of switching off.
- Use proper protection to avoid switching on the voltage accidentally.
- Check that there is no voltage on the switched-off equipment and electrical installations.
- Ground the switched-off equipment and electrical installations.
- · Cover or fence off adjacent live components.


- Work on PV DC sets may only be carried out by qualified electrical technicians. Adequate training and instruction should be provided.






Surge limiter




 Short-circuit protection optional equipment

Assembly instructions


PV DC sets are suitable for protecting outdoor installations. For safe operation and to prevent potential damage, it is recommended that the following recommendations are followed:


• The installation location must not be in an environment where flammable liquids, gases or dust may be present.

• If possible, it is recommended to choose a mounting location where the product will be protected from rain and direct sunlight.

• Cables must be assembled and installed in such a way that they cannot be damaged by rodents.

• The enclosure is designed for wall mounting in a vertical orientation. The forward or backward tilt must not exceed 20°.






DANGER

Possible destruction of the product!

The described IP degree of protection is only valid if the enclosure is undamaged.

- Do not drill additional holes in the enclosure beyond the designated locations.
- Do not modify existing holes.

Protect unused connectors with protective caps (not supplied) to prevent dust and moisture from entering.



* In case of difficult access to the switchgear mounting locations, it is recommended to remove the DIN rail. To do this, unscrew the screw marked in the above drawing, and then slide the rail out of the holder in the direction of the unscrewed screw. Use a torque of 0.8Nm to screw it back in.



Connection instructions

Enclosure connection sequence:

1) Open the housing according to the IDE manufacturer's instructions: 92809_Ed8.FH11 (ide.es).




WARNING

• Do not modify the internal connections as this may affect the operation of the equipment.

2) Unscrew the cable glands to route the cable through it and connect them to the grounding cable clamp.

3) Tighten the cable glands, enter again the cover and tighten screws. Ensure that the housing can be fully closed and is properly seated.

4) Connect the inputs and outputs to the appropriate connectors. For version with assembled cable glands instead of connectors follow according to instruction points no. 2 and 3 by connect the wires to appropriate clamp connectors of the set equipment.

- The operator must ensure that the product is not accessible to unauthorised persons.
- Do not connect PV connectors from different manufacturers.
- Local installation regulations must be observed
- Do not disconnect PV connectors under load.
